

## MILITARY RECRUITER/RELEASE OF STUDENT INFORMATION

Military recruiters and college admissions officers often request access to student names and addresses.

Recognizing the challenges faced by military recruiters, the No Child Left Behind Law requires high schools to provide military recruiters, upon request, access to names, addresses, and phone numbers of high school students. The law also requires high schools to release information to colleges or other higher learning institutions, upon request.

If you do **NOT** want North Star High School to disclose this information without your prior written consent, you must fill out the detachable form below and return it to us by **September 14, 2012**. If we do not receive the form back by this date, we will release the student information to military or college recruiters upon request. If your child is over 18, he or she must sign the form below personally.
